#### The Essentials

- Clothing
- Personal grooming products
- Bedding and room décor \*
- Towels
- Hangers
- Clock/alarm clock, radio
- Wastebasket
- ¾" nails, push pins and blue painters tape\*
- Shower caddy

### **Suggested Items**

- Entertainment equipment such as stereo, TV (must have a QAM tuner)\*, gaming stations
- Bicycle & lock (bike racks are outside each residence hall)
- Computer and printer\*
- Power strips with surge protector (up to 12 feet)
- Small bulletin board
- Dishes, utensils, pots and pans
- Study light for bed or desk
- Single cup brewers such as a Keurig
- Fish in a ten gallon tank or less

### What Not to Bring - These items are not permitted in the apartments

- Television wall mount brackets
- Halogen lamps and bulbs (including Octopus lamps of any kind)
- Refrigerators
- Microwave (Sandage/McMcart residents are permitted to bring one)
- Pets, other than fish
- Double-sided poster tape/3M strips\*
- Candles and incense
- Air conditioners
- Water dispensers
- Routers
- Holiday lights that are not LED Rope format

#### \*Other Details

- Bedding: For the apartments, most of the rooms have extra-long full size beds. Please double check to make sure what bed is in your room assignment before purchasing sheets. Make sure you bring sheets, bedspreads or blankets, and a pillow.
- Hanging Room Décor: Double-sided poster tape or 3M strips may be useful for one or two months, but have shown to leave damages in our apartments and residence halls in the past when used for a full semester. We suggest using small nails (¾" nails) for heavy items, push pins and blue painter's tape for lightweight items. Flat-screen television sets cannot be anchored to the wall.
- Internet: Each apartment and residence hall room provides connection to the residence hall computer network. Students can connect to the internet using wireless or Ethernet connections. This network gives you access to the Internet, e-mail, and the library system. Quetions may be directed to the TCU Help Desk at 817-257-5855.
- Kitchen Appliances: A full-size refrigerator and microwave are provided in the apartments. While we do not provide microwaves for students in Sandage/McCart, these residents are allowed to bring one microwave per apartment. Students are not permitted to bring any other microwave or refrigerator in the apartment. Prohibited appliances are: toaster oven, lava lamps, electric frying pan, deep fryer, ceiling fan, window fan, air conditioner, space heater and halogen lamps.
- Room Fresheners: Scentsy and other type room fresheners are permitted to have the best living environment possible. We recognize that each person may have a different level of tolerance for smells in a room. Please note that use of these products should have the approval from all roommates before use. If there is not roommate approval, these items are not permitted. Please note that candles, incense, and/or any open flame items are not permitted.
