How to Apply:

- Attend an Info Session:** All new IA candidates are required to attend an information session to learn more about the position and determine if this is something you want to pursue. You will have time to meet members of the leadership team, learn about the position, and learn about the upcoming selection process.

 - **Tuesday, March 31 @ 5 p.m. (Zeidman Room – BLUU)**
- Complete the Online Application:** Complete the [IA application](#) no later than **Tuesday, March 31, 2026 at 11:59 p.m. (CST)**.
- Invitation to Interview:** Successful IA candidates will be invited to an in-person interview circuit experience on **Tuesday, April 7, 2026, between 2:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m.**
 - Staff will check application materials, position requirements and your eligibility prior to sending you information about interviews if you are eligible to move to this round.
 - Information for interview circuits will be emailed to you no later than **Thursday, April 2, 2026**.
- IA Notification:** All new IA candidates will receive their decision letters no later than **Wednesday, April 8, 2026**, and must accept or decline their offer by **Friday, April 10, 2026**.
- Preservice/Orientation:** All new staff must attend preservice/orientation held on **Sunday, April 12, 2026, from 2:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m.** (Invitation will be sent to those who are offered positions).

Failure to complete any part of the application or selection process requirements will remove you as a candidate for consideration.
