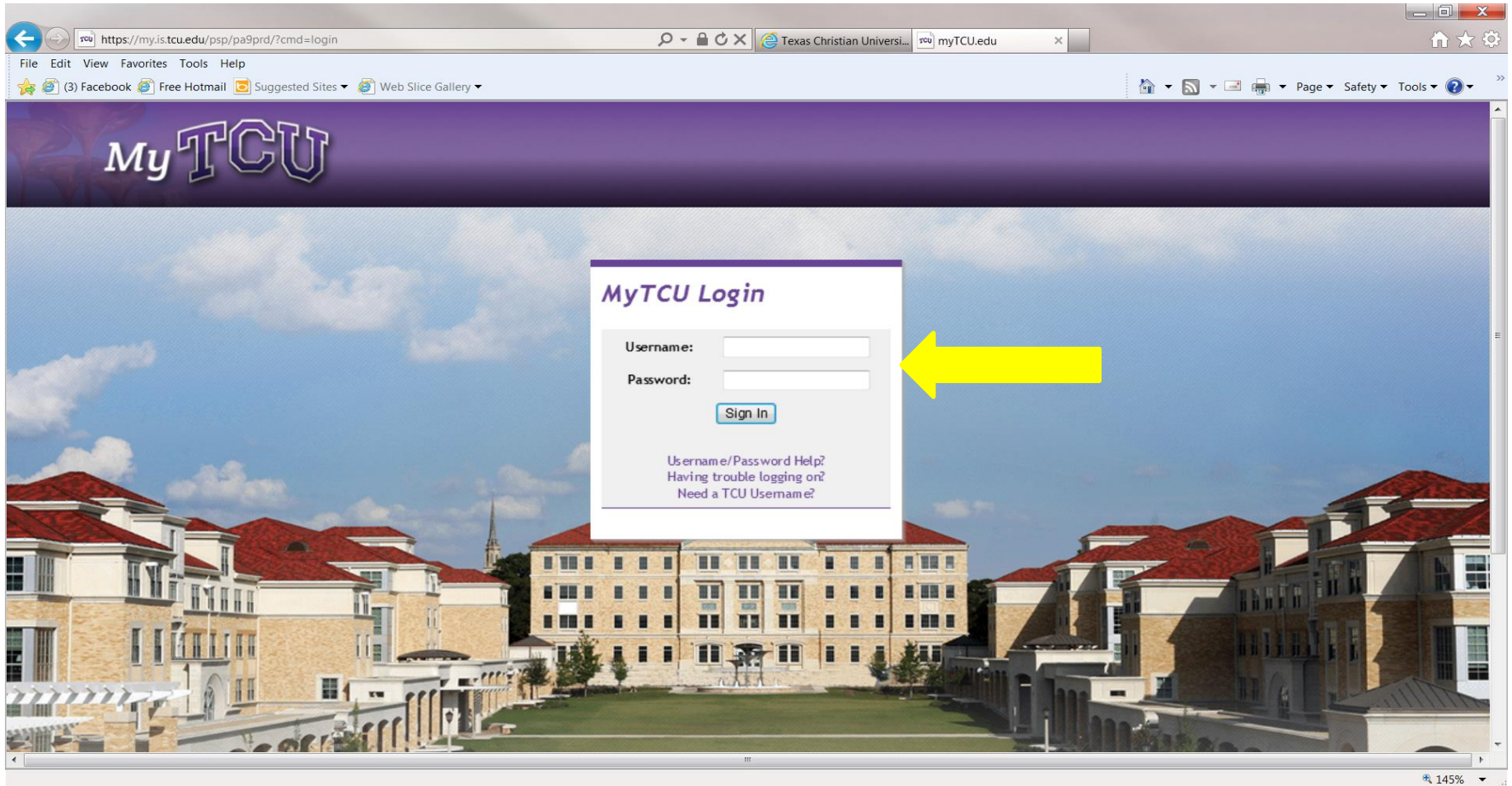

Village East Amenities:

- 2 bedroom/2 bath OR 3 bedroom/3.5 bath units
- Bedrooms will come with an XL-Full bed, desk, chair, 4 drawers and closet (doors are opened not sliding)
- Units come with bar and bar stools (bar stools will equal number of residents, ie. 2 students, 2 bar stools)
- The living room will have entertainment center, coffee table, and either 2 sofas or 1 sofa and love seat or 2 love seats
- Entrance into unit is code access and bedrooms are key locked
- The units located on McCart will have vinyl flooring in the common area and carpet in the bedroom
- The 2 bedroom/2 bathroom units located on Sandage will have thin concrete flooring in common area and carpet in bedrooms
- Residents can receive mail at their residents and packages can be delivered at the leasing office
- Color scheme for Sandage is honey wood furniture
- Color scheme for Merida and McCart is dark wood
- Each bedroom gets an assigned parking space.
- All units come with a full-size washer and dryer and flat screen TV.

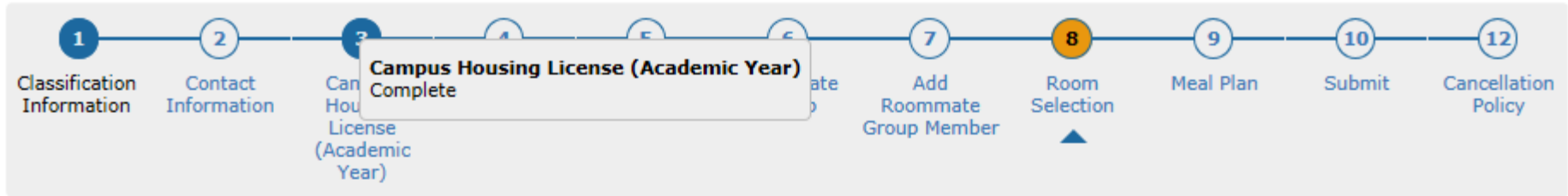

Cancellation Policy

To request a cancellation of your housing, please email **Housing & Residence Life** at **housing@tcu.edu** with your name, TCU ID# and reason for cancellation.

Junior/Senior Housing Assignment Cancellation Policy:

If I cancel my housing assignment **before June 1**, I will not be assessed a cancellation fee.

If I cancel my housing assignment **between June 1 and July 1**, I will be assessed a \$1,000 cancellation fee.

If I cancel my housing assignment **between July 2 and move in or the time I pick up a room key**, I will be assessed a \$2,000 cancellation fee.

If I cancel my housing assignment **after I move in or I pick up a room key**, I will be responsible for full housing charges for the semester.

****If I have not been assigned housing at the time of my cancellation, I will not be assessed a cancellation fee.****

I understand that this is a FULL ACADEMIC YEAR Agreement and I cannot move off campus for the spring semester while remaining a TCU Student (unless I meet one of the approved criteria).
