We are finalizing details on the Housing Application and want to make you aware of a few important reminders before you can tell us about yourself. (*Please keep in mind that preferences are used as guidelines and cannot guarantee placement in a particular hall and/or with a particular roommate.*)

- You can indicate your *preference* to live in an all-female or co-ed community.
- If you are an **Honors** student, you can indicate your *preference* to live in Milton Daniel.
- If you are interested in living in a Freshmen & Continuing Student community, you can indicate that as a *preference*.

**The following items must be submitted before you can access the Housing Application:**

1. \$900 non-refundable Enrollment Deposit
3. Bacterial Meningitis vaccination records (for information, please visit [www.healthcenter.tcu.edu](http://www.healthcenter.tcu.edu)). Please do NOT submit health records to our office. All medical information must be submitted to the TCU Health Center.

The Housing Application will open **May 1 thru June 15** on [my.tcu.edu](http://my.tcu.edu). Changes can be made at any time during those days and the date you submit your Housing Application does not determine your priority to receive an assignment.
