Moncrief: First Year Residence Hall, Co-Ed, Suites, Extended Triples, Lounges, and Suite Style Bathrooms (Community Baths for Lounges only)

PE Clark: First Year and Upperclassmen Residence Hall, Co-Ed, Extended Triples, In-Suite Bathrooms

Sherley: First Year Residence Hall, Co-Ed, Doubles, Extended Triples, Extended Quads, Lounges, Community Style Bathrooms

Waits: First Year Residence Hall, Co-Ed, Doubles, Suites, Built Triples, Extended Triples, Lounges, Community Style Bathrooms and Suite Style Bathrooms

Closed Double = 2 private bedrooms, in-suite living room and bathroom

Open Double = 2 private bedrooms, in-suite bathroom, no living room

Suite Style Bathrooms (Suite Bath) = Bathroom shared with connecting room of the same gender Community Style Bathrooms (Comm. Bath) = Semi-private bathroom shared with floor mates In-Suite Style Bathrooms = Bathrooms located within the suite


ADA = Room caters to students with ADA needs (for example: bathroom grab bars, lower counter tops, wider door frames)

Highlight the rooms you want for everyone in your Roommate Group (if applicable). (For example: if you are in a Roommate Group of 4, you need to highlight two rooms by left clicking each room!)


