WHAT IS THE HOUSING LOTTERY?

The Housing Lottery is the process for rising Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors to choose their on-campus housing assignment for the upcoming academic year.

IMPORTANT HOUSING LOTTERY DATES

MARCH 1-7: HOUSING APPLICATION OPENS

The housing application will open March 1-7 and be accessible via my.tcu.edu.

MARCH 20: FRATERNITY & SORORITY LIFE HOUSING LOTTERY

Approved students will pick their room assignment in their respective chapter facility. Instructions will be sent to students' TCU emails from Fraternity and Sorority Life.

MARCH 26: THE HOUSING LOTTERY

Students with a completed housing application will self-select their room assignments for the 2019-2020 academic year. Instructions will be sent to students' TCU emails from Housing and Residence Life.

APRIL 3: OFF-CAMPUS HOUSING FAIR

This event is for rising Juniors and Seniors who would like to explore off-campus housing options. This will take place on the first and second floors of the BLUU from 1:00PM - 3:00PM.

MOVE-OUT 2019

Residence Halls

All students need to move out either within 24 hours after their last final examination, or by noon on Sunday, May 12. Those students participating in commencement are permitted to move out by 6:00PM on May 12. (Unless moving to summer school housing.)

Fraternity and Sorority Facilities

All students need to move out either within 24 hours after their last final examination, or by noon on Saturday, May 11. (Unless moving to summer school housing.)

Summer School

Students will move into their summer school room assignment in the afternoon of Tuesday, May 14.



Move-Out Instructions

- Pack and remove all personal items from the room
- Remove all trash from the room and place items in the appropriate recycle bins and trash dumpsters
- Clean room: wipe down counters, vacuum, sweep, etc.
- Check out with an RA and follow the detailed check-out directions provided by Housing and Residence Life
- Donate any gently used items to the Donation Station boxes located in and around the residence halls

Donation Station

TCU Housing and Residence Life is excited to collaborate with the Office of Community Engagement to conduct a large scale donation drive for move-out! We are partnering with local charities to set up donation boxes in residence hall lobbies and parking lots for students to donate their unwanted items. Be on the lookout for the boxes!

SUMMER HOUSING

The Summer Housing application will open in April. More information will be sent to students' TCU emails. All additional information such as rates can be found at housing.tcu.edu.

TCU MAILBOXES

TCU mailboxes will automatically renew for the 2019-2020 school year. In summer, mail is forwarded to the students' home address. Please verify that the address is correct on my.tcu.edu.
